POLICY DOCUMENT FOR DIVYANG STUDENTS

The institution believes that persons with disability are entitled to equal opportunities & rights to participate in the educational, social, economic, political and self- development activities in all walks of life. 10. The College is thus committed to provide barrier free access, library resources, scribe and the required relaxation in examination to all divyang students ensuring equal opportunity and full participation.
11. A Wheel Chair, ramp and a Walker shall be made available in the College campus for the needy students.

The Teaching and Non-Teaching staff of the college shall meticulously follow the above policy guidelines and it shall be published on College website.

Smt. Binzani Mahila Mahavidyalaya acknowledges the significance and takes responsibility to initiate measures for energy conservations, eco-friendly destruction of waste, water conservation, green campus initiatives and Divyang Friendly environment.

❖ FACILITIES AND INITIATIVES FOR ENERGY CONSERVATION

Following are the facilities set up in the institution to ensure energy conservation:

1. The college started replacing all the tubelights in the campus with LED Lights since the session 2018-19.
2. Solar lamps with 15W light, 12 AH battery 50W panel have been installed in the campus.

❖ DEGRADABLE AND NON-DEGRADABLE WASTE MANAGEMENT

Solid waste management:

1. Sufficient dustbins are made available in the campus. Dustbins are kept in the classrooms, Canteen and corridors.
2. Solid waste which is accumulated is separated as degradable and non-degradable in separate dustbins. It is disposed off on daily basis.
3. The college has set up a Natural Compost Unit. Green garbage collected in the campus is collected in it and used for making natural compost.
4. Old waste news-papers in the library are donated to 'Malhar Foundation', an NGO for making Paper bags since the year 2014.

Biomedical waste management:

5. The college bought Sanitary Napkin vending Machine and Burning Incinerator on 16 August 2017. Burning incinerator is installed in Students' Wash room. During lockdown period it was not used and needed to be repaired. It was recently repaired in the current session 2022-23. SBMM Alumni Association borne the expenses of the repair. It is working and regularly maintained.

E-waste and Plastic waste management:

The college signed an MoU with Aaranya Paryavaran Sanstha, a recognised E-waste collection center by Nagpur Municipal Corporation on 15th of December 2021 for eco-friendly

destruction of E-waste and plastic waste. E-waste and plastic waste accumulated in the institution is donated to the sanstha after being certified by write off and maintenance Committee of the college.

Green Cell of the college also makes an appeal to the staff members and the students to bring E-waste and plastic waste from their homes and contribute in this environment friendly venture of the college. The college donated first lot of E-waste and plastic waste on 6th of May 2022 and second on 24th of December 2022 to Aaranya Paryavaran Sanstha.

Another lot of E-waste and plastic waste was handed over to M/s Threco Recycling LLP, Mumbai for recycling on 2nd of December 2022.

❖ WATER CONSERVATION

The college purchased and installed rooftop rain water harvesting system on 10th of October 2016. The water accumulated on the roof is used to recharge a bore well With approximately 9.7 Lakh lit water per year. It is maintained by Gargi Minerals Industry Consultant, Nagpur.

❖ GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

Every year on 16th July, the foundation day of the college, tree plantation program is organized. Saplings are distributed among the staff members and students also to be planted in their neighborhood.

The campus is beautifully landscaped with herbal plants, fruit bearing trees, flowering plants and ornamental plants.

Posters have been displayed in the campus to create awareness among staff and students about importance of greenery and hazards of pollution on environment and human health.

❖ DISABLED FRIENDLY ENVIRONMENT

The college has a well drafted policy for divyang students. Following it, facilities like ramps are build up in the campus, scribe is provided and extra time is allotted during exam time, audio-visual study material is made available in the Library.



Dear Madam,

With reference to above letter, we have submitted the quotation for Rainwater Harvesting (RWH) consultancy work. The actual quoted amount was Rs.15,400/-. But the total expenditure incurred for the present consultancy work is Rs.20,765/-.


Previously, the roof area covered is small but for the more recharge and storage the roof area is extended to the limit of approx 1000sq.ft. Therefore, the requirement of more number of outlets is also increased. As the roof area is more there is requirement of large size pipes. The used pipe size is 4 inches (IS) marks of length 180 ft and ball valve. Similarly as the more area covered the plumbing charges also get increased. Hence the overall expenditure is increased by the sum of Rs.5,365/-.

Due to the large area coverage the recharge of rainwater and tank water will be increased and ultimately results into the increase in groundwater level. This RWH structure will prove to be fruitful for the groundwater future prospects of the proposed area. 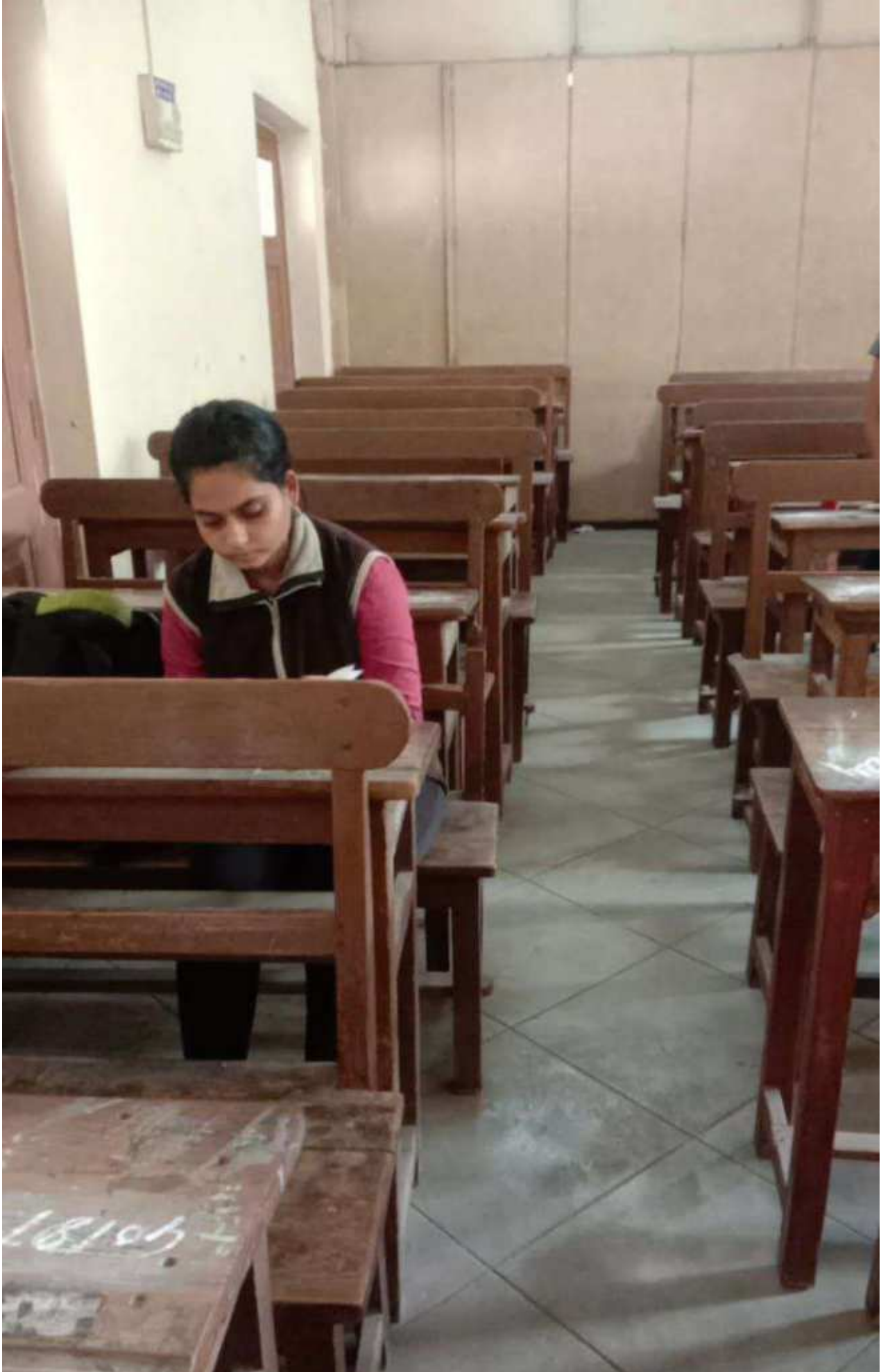

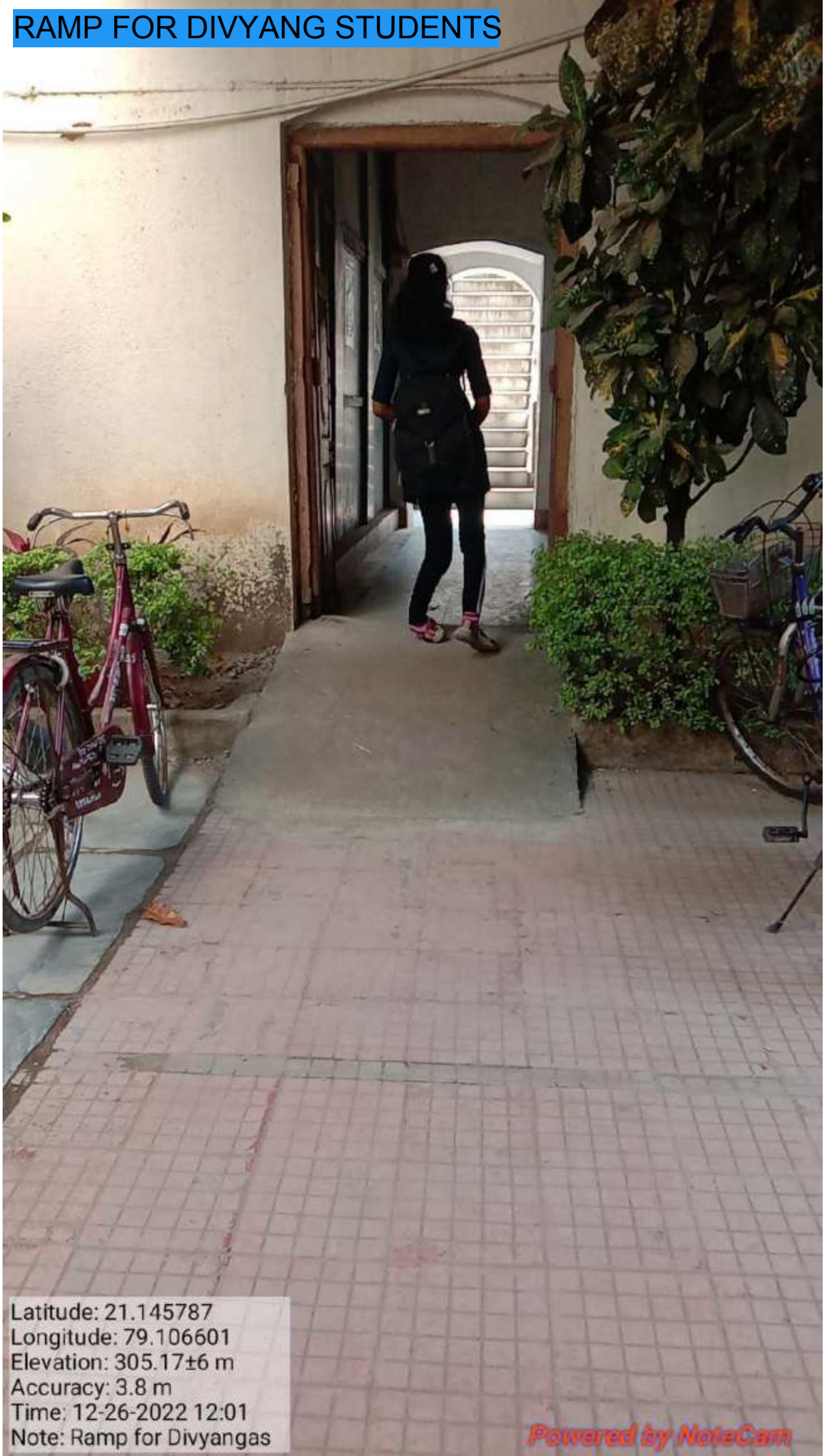
