STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY

2022-23

In the year 2022-23, Students Satisfaction survey was conducted. Especially the teaching and other activities were both offline and online. Near about 117 students gave the feedback regarding teaching learning methods, class activities and their experiences. The following are main points of the Student Satisfaction Survey:-

- 23.9% students of B.A.III year responded to the survey, 37.6% were of B.A IInd year and 35% were of Ist year.
- Mainly 50.5% students were of Marathi medium and 48.7% students were of Hindi medium.
- On asking whether they got apt counselling from the college Counselling Committee at the time of admission, 76.7%% answered positively while 23.3% responded negatively.
- Students were asked about teachers conducting bridge Course at the beginning of the syllabus. 86.5% students said "Yes" while 13.5% responded negatively.
- On asking about the previous year's teaching, 52.1% students said that it was Satisfactory, 44.4% said that it was very satisfactory, while 4.5% students were not satisfied by the teaching.
- Students were asked whether the teachers complete the syllabus in the class. 97.4% students responded positively and 3% student did not confirm the fact.
- 97.4% students were of the opinion that they find their syllabus very useful.
- They were asked whether their syllabus is adequate and interesting.
 97.4% students gave positive response.
- On asking the students whether they like the teachers using computer projector for teaching, 90.4% students replied positively and 9.6% students do not like it.
- On asking about the enriching activities conducted by the teachers, 57.8% students find it satisfactory, 32.8% found it very satisfactory and remaining 9.5% suggested making improvements.

- Students were asked whether the teachers conduct remedial class for failed and slow learners. 68.1% students said 'Yes' while 31.9% students replied negatively.
- On asking about the facilities provided by the Library, 82.8% students said that the facilities are good, 11.2% students were satisfied with it and 6% students suggested improvements.
- About Computer training facility, 82.8% students liked it, 12.9% students are satisfied and 5.6% students want improvements.
- Students were asked whether there is a centre for Competitive Exam guidance. 97.4% students responded positively and 3.3% students had no idea about it.
- Students were asked whether they have completed Certificate courses conducted by the college. 78.9% students replied positively and 21.1% students did not attend the courses.
- 93% students found the courses useful and 7% students did not found it useful.
- On asking the students how they find the college rooms and Labs, 60.9% students appreciated, 29.6% students found them satisfactory and 9.6% students suggested improvements.
- Students were asked whether the programs conducted by IQAC and VUM are useful for their development. 93.9% students admitted the fact while 6.1% students denied it.
- They were asked whether college conduct collegiate exams for Internal Evaluation system. 65.5%% students said that it is conducted very particularly, 31% said that it is conducted satisfactorily, rest suggested for improvements.
- Students were also asked about the organisation of educational visits and guest lectures in the college. 93.1% students responded positively while 6.9% students said "No".
- On asking about the programs of Alumni Association, such as "Mile Sur Mera Tumhara",66.7% student said that they were very good, 28.9% were satisfactory and rest suggested improvements.
- 96.5% students said that Udyogini Pradarshini Exhibition should be organised every year.
- On asking about the studying atmosphere in the college, 69.6% students said that it is very good, 23.5% said that it is satisfactory while 7% suggested the need for improvement.

Students were asked about the facilities provided by the college. Students ratio is given in the following way:-

- 10.3% students took part in Swara Academy, 6% in Tana Bana Academy, 15.4% in Dhyey Academy, 12.8% in ICT Academy and rest of the students did not participated in any Academy.
- In participating in Academies 37.6% students found it very interesting, 45.3% students were satisfied and rest suggested improvement in the academies.
- On asking about the participation in Project Parth, 58.1 students responded positively, rest 41.9 % did not participate.
- 13.7% students took part in Placement Drive of SBI Life, 7.7% in both Stop Cancer Mission and SBI, rest 76.1% did not participate in any drive.
- 55.6% student have idea about Aroha Internship, 44.4% did not participate.
- On asking about the new improvements in college building, 60.7% like it very much, 25.6% found it good, 10.3% students found it ok.
- On asking about the College Library, 91.5% responded positively, while 8.5% did not like.
